

WPA XVII WORLD CONGRESS OF PSYCHIATRY BERLIN 2017

Guidelines for ePoster (electronic Poster) Presentation

ePoster presentations are an important component of the WPA XVII WORLD CONGRESS OF PSYCHIATRY BERLIN 2017 for communicating new research findings. They should describe the highlights of the research projects, pointing out the aims, methods and results of the work.

ePoster authors are required to be available at the respective ePoster terminal during the poster walks to discuss their work with colleagues. ePoster walks executed in English will take place from 13:30-15:00 on Monday to Thursday and will be guided by well reputed experts who will act as chairpersons. Each ePoster presentation has an allotted time of 5 minutes including a brief discussion.

ePoster authors are required to disclose any relevant financial or other relationship that may lead to a potential bias at the bottom of their ePoster. Conflicts of interest may exist through a financial relationship or when the individual has the opportunity to influence the content of a presentation, and can involve grants, honoraria, shares, paid positions on advisory boards, etc. This will allow the audience to take potential conflicts of interest into account when assessing the objectivity of the presentation.

With the abstract submission the author has accepted the general conditions for this congress. It is not allowed to transfer the authorship or the ePoster(s) to someone else. A contribution can only be included in the scientific programme after the participation fee has been paid.

If the ePoster author is not able to upload and present its poster, the Congress and Exhibition Office CPO HANSER SERVICE must be informed on time by email to wpa2017@cpo-hanser.de.

ePoster Description

An ePoster is a static, visual medium that is used to communicate scientific data and other messages. The difference between ePoster and oral presentations is that the ePoster do the most of the 'communication'. The task of an author is to answer questions from poster visitors and to provide further details on request.

The content of an effective ePoster presentation should be clear, focused, and concise. Furthermore, it usually contains eye-catching illustrations, diagrams, graphs and/or photographs with clear and attractive layouts.

Format and Material for ePosters

ePosters will be shown on 60 inch screens, controlled by an iPad. By using common techniques such as “pinch to zoom” poster authors are able to present different parts of the ePoster in more detail.

Please hand in your ePoster as a 1-page PDF-file in portrait orientation. Please read the following technical requirements:

- File format: .pdf (single page PDF)
- In pixel: 1536 height x 1080 width (portrait orientation)
- In cm: 54,2 height x 38,1 width (portrait orientation)
- Font size: Minimum 16pt

ePoster authors that would like to upload an ePoster with video files should send an email to wpa2017@cpo-hanser.de.

Video format

- Video must be embedded inside the pptx-file
- Video formats: .mp4, .mpg, .mov, .avi
- Video size: Max. 40 MB
- Video length: Max 30 sec
- Sound: not supported
